Welcome to a new club year. This letter provides useful information about All Nations Armed Ready Ministering Youth that involves God's ARMY Pathfinder Club, Little Warriors Adventurers and God's ARMY Drum Corp, its policies, objectives, and activities. Please read it carefully before completing registration.

We aim to help your youth develop a strong love of God and an appreciation of, and respect for the world He made for us to live in. At each of our club meetings, we repeat the Pathfinder and Adventurer Pledge and Law and follow with a devotional thought. Our meetings will consist of class work, earning honors and recreational activities, as well as opportunities to help in the community.

Our Objectives every year include completing three areas of enrichment: class work, advanced class work and honors finishing the Investiture books. Each unit (grade level) has a class ("Sunbeam", "Eager Beaver" "Friend", "Companion", "Explorer", etc). Each of these classes also has an advanced portion in addition to it. These are both designed to improve the Pathfinder/Adventurer and help them to be of a greater service to God and their Community. If successfully completed, the youth are invested in these classes at the end of the year (close to the end of the school year). This year it will be held on May 18, 2024. They can then improve their dress uniform (Type A) with the patches they earn. Opportunities for community service are an important part of our program, and involvement in church, school, family, or neighborhood projects is encouraged.

Extra Honors and Class work

Additional honors and class work may be completed outside of club meetings. These can also be done virtually (Zoom). Honor requirements are available online at clubministries.org. We recommend worksheets available online or from our club are completed when doing this. Patches may be purchased for honors or class work completed outside of club meetings, when a club staff member is satisfied that all requirements have been met. Evidence may include completed worksheets, craft projects or photos and a report or parent/guardian verification that all was done.

Schedule & Announcements

A schedule will be provided at registration for the year. During the year, emails and notes are sent with updates and announcements regularly. Thus, it is very important to provide an email address through which you can be informed of all club activities on a regular basis. Please keep informed by checking your email. We also have a WhatsApp to provide immediate information for any schedule changes. This can be joined by youth and adults alike. Please use the QR code below.

God's ARMY Drum Corp- Will meet Mondays from 6pm-8pm. You are expected to practice daily at home the homework given. We practice for upcoming parades and other activities throughout the year. There is a Band APP for updates, practice videos and information pertaining to the corp. Please join requesting invitation by texting 918-906-0535.

Bible Achievement Team

Six members and an alternate of God's ARMY/Little Warriors will be asked to join the PBE. We encourage every member to join the Bible study group that will begin in August to prepare for this. All Pathfinders/Adventurers who are not on this team are encouraged to continue active Bible study with the group. The competition is encouraging as it is how much do you know vs against another team. There are four levels of advancement: Area, Conference, Union & Division.

Optional Activities

In addition to our regularly scheduled meetings, we have various other activities planned for your Pathfinder/Adventurer that are optional, where attendance is not required. This year, these include outreach ministry, AYA social every 5th Sabbath after AYA and other activities as time and opportunity make possible... Parents, please ask your Pathfinder/Adventurer to show you notices with details of upcoming events or schedule changes. We will email announcements and update the WhatsApp to all parents and Pathfinders who supply an email address and join the app.

We ask for \$50 annually for membership dues that can be paid at registration or in a payment plan. Please let us know if there is financial need as scholarships are available. These cover the expenses incurred by class meetings, class camps and maintenance of camping equipment, honors supplies, etc. A \$5 per member discount is available to families with two or more children in Pathfinders or Adventurers. Please note that this does not cover the expense of food or transportation to these events or the cost of

supplies for the honors and activities that we will undertake this year, but we will try to raise this in a variety of ways. Remember the International Camporee is in Gillette, Wyoming August 12–17, 2024.

Uniform

To be a member of the Club, your Pathfinder/Adventurer will need a field uniform and a full-dress uniform.

- Field uniform consists of a club t-shirt and jeans. Club t-shirts will be given at registration. If extra is needed, this can be purchased.
- **Dress uniform** includes black pants for boys and modest, black skirts or slacks for girls; a khaki shirt or blouse with all patches; an official Pathfinder belt; a yellow scarf; and a black honor sash. Adventurers will have blue pants or girls jump skirt, white or blue shirt, scarf, and honor sash.
- Ask for a chart to correctly position insignia on a dress uniform shirt.
- Uniform pants will be worn with belt and shirts tucked in just as with skirts

The Club can assist you in ordering uniform parts or you may purchase these items on your own, if they have the exact features of the uniform parts ordered from Advent Source. Used uniform parts that another Pathfinder has outgrown may be available at a reduced price at the time of registration. If you already have a uniform, we ask that you please bring at the time of registration so that we can make sure that you have all parts.
